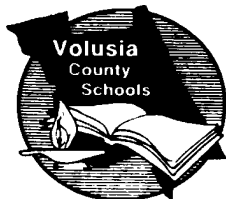

Services Offered:

Beginning Reading; ESL; Workplace Literacy; Family Literacy; Computer Lab, Math; Laubach Volunteer tutor training.

Instructional Style:

One-to-One Tutoring. Uses Volunteer Tutors.

Eligible Participants:

16 and 17 year olds not in public/private school; 18 years and older reading at a 5th grade level or below.

Training of Volunteers:

8 Hour Basic tutor; 8 hour ESL tutor training; Laubach method; and bimonthly in-service.

Locations of Instruction:

Churches; Schools; Libraries; Community College; Businesses; Public locations throughout Volusia County.

To Enter:

Applicant is interviewed and evaluated to determine skill level in reading, comprehension, spelling, math, and individual goals. Applicant is then assigned to an appropriate volunteer tutor. Student assessment by Daytona Beach Screening Device (DSD), and the Basic English Skills Test (BEST).

Description:

Individualized instruction to adults needing skills in basic reading, writing, math, daily living skills, English as a Second Language, and performance based skills. Member of LLA, AFLO and the Florida Literacy Coalition.
