To Enter:

Student contacts the Coordinator who takes basic information and matches student to tutor.

Description:

Program provides basic literacy services in one-to-one and small group settings at central and remote sites throughout the county. Affiliate of Literacy Volunteers of America, utilizing volunteer tutor training and support materials. Computer-assisted instruction offered wherever feasible.

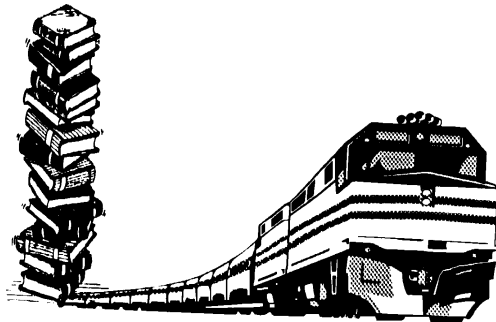
